

Fujitsu Services Dispute, Manchester

Head Office has circulated to Branches a copy of Ian Allinson's report on the Fujitsu Services Dispute issued on 5th March 2007.

In the report Ian informed us that the Fujitsu Service members were taking strike action due to the Company's anti-union activities, failing to recognise previous agreements on union recognition, redundancy and redeployment, time off for union duty and failing to fully implement pay agreements. It is clear that this type of behaviour is totally unacceptable and needs to be challenged. The report went on to appeal for donations towards this campaign.

Dear John,

I am enclosing a cheque for £200 as a donation to your on-going dispute with Fujitsu. The donation is from our union branch, rather than a personal one, although I admit to having a personal interest.

I worked for ICL for 29 years before my job was hit by the great cull at the demise of ICL. I have been receiving the newsletters from Manchester ever since and have been taking considerable interest in your continuing battle with a company that I must say I am glad to be out of.

When I first joined ICL there was a fairly good relationship between the company and the union. It all started to go bad when the Americans moved in on us and deteriorated with the Japanese. Sounds racist, I know, but it was sad to see the decline of the only serious British computer firm.

I have been particularly angered by the disciplinary attacks on Ian and Gary, simply for doing the job they were elected to do in an exemplary manner. The organisation of this dispute certainly leaves any previous ones in the dust. National media coverage, let alone parliamentary, is hard to get.

I will be watching, and hoping for a successful outcome to the dispute, while I am working locally, for a fraction of the salary, but happy and relatively stress-free.
